As I am sure you are aware, the Times today, citing anonymous sources, has a story about your apparent \$1,100 PayPal payments to Justin Berry during summer 2005.

I am doing an article today for Counterpunch, also based on information from sources close to the July 31 Nashville court proceedings who wish to remain anonymous. Please respond to the following items and questions. I need your response today (Wednesday) by 1:00 p.m. Central time. You can email, or call me at (917) 443-1407.

Questions below:

* Sources say that pseudonymous "Andrew McDonald," with email skywrite55@aol.com <<mailto:skywrite55@aol.com>> , sent \$1,100 via PayPal to Justin Berry in June 2005 to buy images of him. They say messages appended to some of the payments talk about photos of Berry being good quality or bad quality, and that some will be paid for and others not. I am also told there is a message indicating the buyer says he has ideas help Berry make more money.

My questions: were these photographs pornographic? Were they of Justin when he was underage? Why were you buying photos of Justin Berry from him? Did you tell Berry you had ideas to help him make money? If so, what were they and why did you tell him this?

* Sources say pseudonym "Roy" with email skywrite55@aol.com became a subscriber to Justinsfriends.com in late June 2005. This appears to be you.

Please respond.

* Sources say records indicate this subscriber was given the same administrative privileges to enter justinsfriends.com that Berry, Greg Mitchel and others had to manage the site and view subscriber information. The sources say this subscriber signed on, using these privileges, dozens of times in June and July 2005, and viewed subscriber sign up information. Please comment.

* Sources say the "Roy" skywrite55@aol.com subscription to justinsfriends.com was canceled on July 14, 2005. You testified at the Gourlay trial that this was the same period when you sat with Berry and reviewed the contents of his computer hard drives. Did you or he cancel the subscription then?

* Sources add that \$1,000 was wired to Berry in Bakersfield on July 5, 2005 from a Western Union office less than three miles from your home in Dallas. The sender used a fake name and address. What do you know about this? If you were the sender, why did you do this?

* Please comment on information that you currently under investigation by the FBI because of evidence you were involved in Berry's child pornography enterprise.
