**O R D E R**

The Magistrate Judge, at the request of Judge Trauger, has reviewed the third party movants' proposed redactions from the pleadings previously filed in this suit (Docket Entry No. 271). This review was made more difficult because counsel referred to Items A through I as being contained in Docket Entry No. 285, and Items J through M as being contained in Docket Entry No. 251). After a considerable amount of search by the Magistrate Judge and his staff, it was determined that the materials listed as being in Docket Entry No. 255 were actually contained in Docket Entry No. 251, and the materials listed as contained in Docket Entry No. 251 were actually contained in Docket Entry No. 245.

The defendant's counsel responded to these suggested redactions in his own pleading (Docket Entry No. 273).

The Magistrate Judge believes that defendant's counsel has the better argument in this matter. As the Magistrate Judge understands it, Judge Trauger denied the motion to quash with the exception that the undersigned would review the matter to redact

immaterial matters. A hearing concerning the relevancy of this was held in open court. Accordingly, the Magistrate Judge believes that the only further redactions that are necessary to the materials cited in Docket Entry Nos. 251 and 245 are Exhibits H through J the first twelve digits of a MasterCard account number should be deleted. In Item K, the street address and zip code should be deleted. In Item L, the first twelve digits of the Visa account number should be deleted. In Item M, the street address and zip code should be deleted.

There is some duplication in this list. Items marked H and J are identical as well as Items I and L. The Magistrate Judge has made the necessary redactions from these documents and they are attached to this order. They are marked at the bottom with the appropriate tabs H and J, K, I and L, and M.

It is the Magistrate Judge's understanding that Judge Trauger will be conducting further hearings in this matter on Monday, August 20, 2007, and she will make the final decision as to what additional materials, if any, should be removed from under seal. The Magistrate Judge is of the view that he has made the necessary redactions from Docket Entry Nos. 245 and 251.

It is so **ORDERED**.
