Dear Mr. Eichenwald:

AOL LLC ("AOL") has received a subpoena issued by Peter J. Strianse, attorney for defendant in *United States of America v. Timothy Ryan Richards*, in the U.S. District Court, Middle District of Tennessee, Case No: 3:05-00185, in anticipation of a hearing scheduled to take place on August 17, 2007. The subpoena, a copy of which is enclosed, commands AOL to produce certain records which identify you as the account holder of AOL e-mail address skvwrite55@aol.com, and also commands the production of "billing and payment information" and other AOL email addresses registered by you.

The AOL Member Privacy Policy states:

Your AOL Member information, including the contents of your private online communications, may be accessed and disclosed in response to legal process (for example, a court order, search warrant or subpoena) * * *

When AOL receives legal process in these circumstances, we notify the Member whose records and information are sought so that the Member will have an opportunity to make an appearance in court and to pursue any legal remedy that may be available

In accordance with our policy, AOL plans to produce the requested documents to Mr. Strianse in response to the subpoena on or about July 17, 2007.
