ORDER

Non-party Kurt Eichenwald has filed objections to only one of the Orders issued by Magistrate Judge Brown, Docket No. 283. (Docket No. 301) Defendant Richards has responded to these objections. (Docket No. 304)

The first objection requests that references to his minor son's AOL e-mail account be redacted from page 2 (1 entry) and page 6 (2 entries) of the AOL return (Docket No. 284-3). (Docket No. 301 at 2-3) The defendant does not oppose this redaction, and it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Magistrate Judge shall make this redaction to the AOL subpoena return.


The second objection by non-party Eichenwald requests a protective order "prohibiting the fruits of the Subpoenas . . .to be disseminated by any party, attorney or any other person in possession of same. . . ." (Docket No. 301 at 3) This objection is opposed by the defendant and would be contrary to this court's previous determination that all documents filed in connection with non-party Eichenwald's Motion to Quash would come out from under seal after the appropriate redactions. This objection is therefore **DENIED**.

Pursuant to this court's previous Order of July 31, 2007 (Docket No. 268), it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Clerk shall take out from under seal all docket entries filed in connection with non-party Kurt Eichenwald's Motions to Quash Subpoenas and Request For Sanctions (Docket Nos. 245, 260), which documents are as follows: Docket Nos. 244, 245, 247, 248, 251, 255, 257, 260, 261, 262, 271, 273, 278, 284, 290, and 293.

It is further **ORDERED** that Magistrate Judge Brown shall file, along with the redacted AOL return, redacted copies of Docket Nos. 301, 302 and 304, after having redacted the e-mail address of non-party Eichenwald's minor son.

It is so **ORDERED**.
