
ORDER

Pursuant to the Ex Parte Motion filed by the government on August 8, 2008 (Docket No. 346), it is hereby **ORDERED** that the government shall disclose to defense counsel only the document attached to the Ex Parte Motion. It is further **ORDERED** that defense counsel shall not give a copy of this document to the defendant or to any other person but shall utilize its contents only for purposes of formulating arguments to be presented to the court, if any. The court has serious reservations about the materiality of this document as it relates to either *Giglio v. United States*, 405 U.S. 150 (1972) or *Brady v. Maryland*, 373 U.S. 83 (1963), but, out of an abundance of precaution, is of the opinion that it should be disclosed to defense counsel prior to the defendant's sentencing.

It is further **ORDERED** that any motions or other papers filed by defense counsel that reveal the contents of the document to be disclosed shall be filed **under seal**.

It is so **ORDERED**.
