ORDER

An evidentiary hearing was held on July 24, 2006 on the defendant's pretrial motions. For the reasons stated on the record at the close of the hearing, which are incorporated herein by reference as if set forth verbatim, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the defendant's Motion to Suppress Fruits of Warrantless Arrest (Docket No. 78) is **DENIED**, and the defendant's Motion to Suppress Fruits of Seizures and Subsequent Searches of Computer Servers (Docket No. 80) is **DENIED**.¹

It is further **ORDERED** that the defendant's Motion for Identification of Images (Docket No. 77) is **GRANTED**. In furtherance thereof, the Scheduling Order previously entered (Docket No. 70) is modified as follows:

1. The government shall produce to the defendant copies of the images that it intends to introduce in its case in chief at trial by August 25, 2006.
2. Both parties shall make their expert disclosures by September 8, 2006.
3. Both parties shall file objections to the expert disclosures, *Daubert* challenges and motions in limine by September 15, 2006.
4. Responses to objections and motions shall be filed by September 22, 2006.


¹At the hearing, the defendant withdrew his motion to suppress as to the NEOVA.net server maintained by Hurricane Electric in Fremont, California.

The hearing on motions in limine and objections to experts shall remain scheduled for September 29, 2006 at 1:00 p.m., and the trial remains scheduled for October 10, 2006.

The government has represented that any superseding indictment returned before trial will not add additional defendants, and the defendant has expressed his desire to go to trial on October 10, 2006, even if a superseding indictment is returned prior thereto.

It is so **ORDERED**.
